Marine Aggregate Dredging: The Alternative

Thank you for your letter received 20 October 2015 and for sharing your paper explaining how sand might be manufactured from quarry waste.

As you are aware the Marine Management Organisation (MMO) is responsible for regulating the deposit or removal of substances or objects from the seabed or elsewhere in tidal waters under the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009. Any decisions surrounding the sourcing of aggregate is a commercial one for the aggregate and construction industry, not a decision the MMO would make.

I hope that this clarifies the position, and again, I would like to thank you for sharing the report with us.
