



5. You suggest that organisations such as Marinet be allowed to participate in the work of the TWG. Our main concern with this approach is that if all such organisations participated, it would prolong the process as discussed in paragraph 3, above. Also there would seem little point on having a separate ECEN in such circumstances. We will be able to provide some outputs from the meeting (for example powerpoint slides from presentations given) in advance of the ECEN meeting.
6. With regard to your comments on sea fishing, we would be grateful if you could provide the names of the fishing organisations that your members are associated with so that we can establish if any relevant organisations have not been contacted. In the meantime, we enclose a copy of the fisheries liaison protocol for your reference.

We trust our response answers your points as far as possible and thank you again for your participation in the East Channel Environmental Network.
